VP Societies and Events: Working on a GSA board game night and an end of the summer bbq event in conjunction with the SJ GSA.

VP Academic: Working with Executive Director to try and get moving on a possible new deck through facilities management; positions coming open for various UNB committees, will be sending out calls for these spots.

6. Committee Reports

WCB/Executive Director: Been talking to UNB Facilities Management about a new deck and accessibility issues with the Grad House; worked with OMNI services and facilities management to improve some Grad House things including electrical work, basement inspection, stairs outside the front door, outside lights repaired, safety lights getting replaced, stair treads being replaced, dishwasher repaired and inspected, moving forward to get a new deck, yard cleaned, basement ceiling repaired; meeting with executive committee members on issues for orientation, finances, old computers, ISICs and UNB committees. GSA President: the funds for this would come from both the GSA and the bar. We have some money from past years with CFS.

Discussion on position:

- 2 year contract (renewal after 1), maximum six thousand from each GSA and Bar sides.
- Does GSA need this position or would it benefit?
- The entire role is based on increasing the profit of the bar and then tracking it.
- Discussion on budget and where the GSA/bar is financially. Discussion on whether the position comes from both GSA and bar.

Motion to approve 1 year contract with extension of 1 year and maximum of six thousand per year from GSA , moved by VP External, seconded by VP Administration.

Motion to approve position and designed and amended moved by Psychology and seconded by Forestry, passed.
